**PRESCRIPTION UNDER THE ACTIVITIES LOCAL LAW 2024 ('Local Law')**

1. In exercise of:
  - 1.1. an instrument of delegation from the Council to the Chief Executive Officer dated 28 October 2025 made pursuant to section 11(1) the *Local Government Act 2020* ('the Act')
  - 1.2. an instrument of sub-delegation from the Chief Executive Officer to Council staff dated 18 December 2025
  - 1.3. all other powers held by or delegated to me, and having taken into account the local law requirements of the Council pursuant to the *Local Government Act 2020*.

**THE COUNCIL PRESCRIBES THAT:**

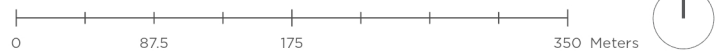
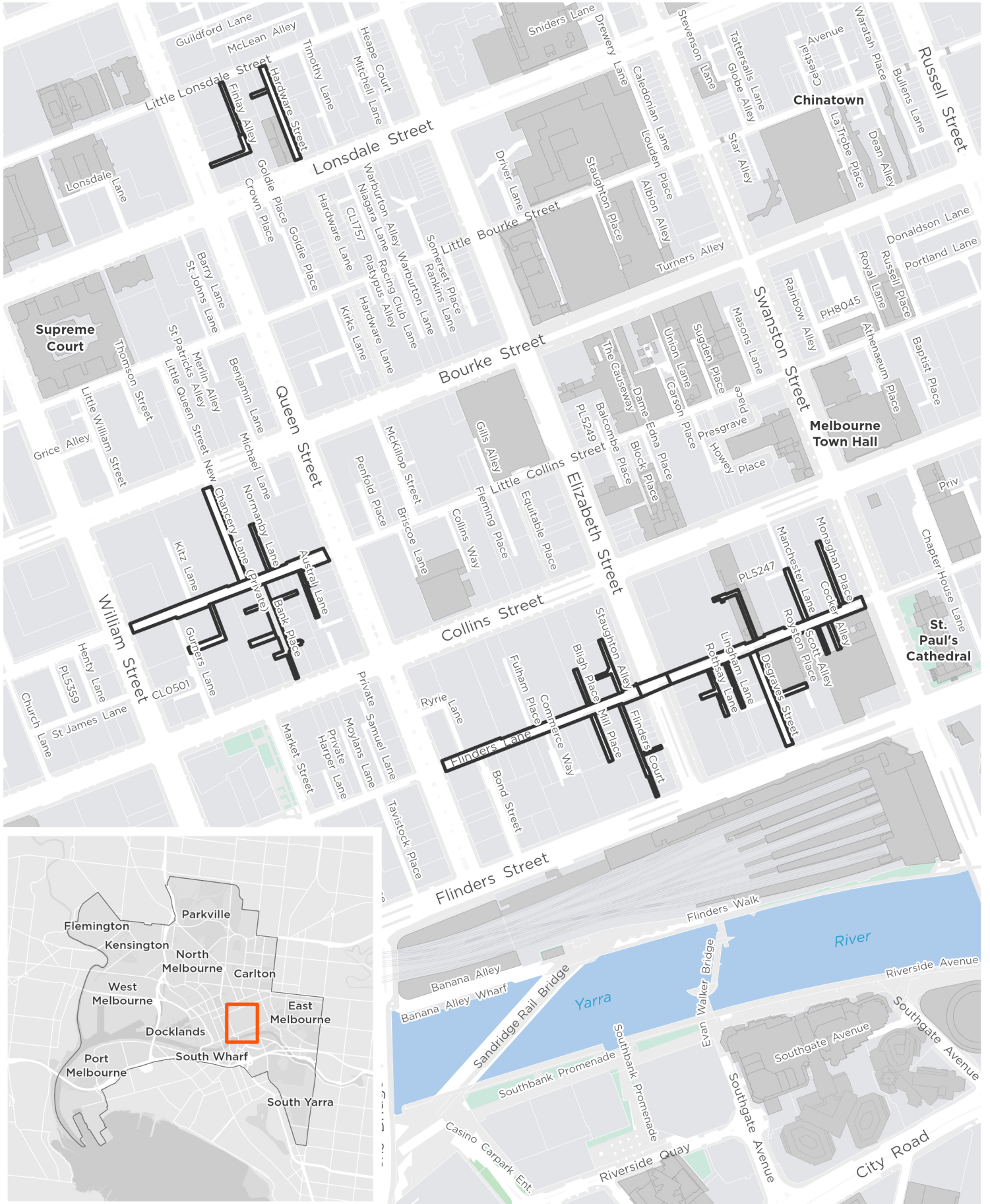
2. Subject to paragraph 3 below, unless in accordance with a permit under the Local Law, a person must not collect waste or allow waste to be collected from those parts of the municipality shown in bold and defined as 'Restricted Access Areas Hot Spot' on the attached map.
3. This prescription does not apply to waste collection where the collection is by the Council or a contractor for the Council in either of the following situations:
  - 3.1. the waste collection is from a Council operated waste compactor, including collection from bins in lieu of a waste compactor when the compactor is inoperative
  - 3.2. the waste collection is from a public waste bin, being a Council managed receptacle/bin installed on a public footpath for use by the community to dispose of everyday small waste items.
